



## 2018 NSERC Discovery Grant (NOI) Notice of Intent – deadline August 1, 2017

As we approach the 2018 NSERC Discovery Grant competition, we wanted to inform all eligible NSERC Discovery grant applicants of the upcoming **mandatory Notice of Intent (NOI)**. NSERC has recently contacted all known potential applicants directly (including researchers on their last instalment of a Discovery Grant, or who applied unsuccessfully in the 2017 competition) to remind them of the upcoming **August 1, 2017, 8 pm EST** NOI deadline.

The mandatory Notice of Intent form for the 2018 Discovery Grant competition is now available through the new NSERC Research Portal. In order to apply for a Discovery Grant in November 2017, an applicant **MUST** complete and submit an online Notice of Intent **by 8 pm EST on August 1, 2017**. If you do not submit a Notice of Intent by the deadline, you will **NOT** be eligible to apply in November for a 2018 Discovery Grant.

In addition, please note that NSERC will host webinars to assist RTI applicants on “How to submit an application” using the Research Portal and the NSERC Canadian Common CV (CCV).
