This program is specifically to support multi-disciplinary, multi-investigator discovery and translational research projects that connect clinicians with scientists and scientists with the Huntington Disease (HD) community in a manner that can be demonstrated to create collaborative HD Clinician-Scientist-to-Patient Virtual Networks. This program aims to foster research that will expand our understanding of the natural history and pathophysiology of HD in humans in a manner that can be demonstrated to yield new information and resources that will ultimately improve the lives of those who carry the HD mutation. The patient-focused projects can address, for example, the realms of patient care, therapeutics that slow or prevent the disease processes responsible for the onset and progression of HD, clinical trial oriented measures and designs, and many others. The results of these projects may also provide new starting points for looking at other neurodegenerative disorders.

The workshop will facilitate the opportunity for applicants to consider collaboration with other neurological disease researchers and, therefore, we strongly encourage applicants to participate in this beneficial teleconference workshop.
